




It was sad to have lost my brother two weeks ago as he navigated for me in the P76 and at one time had a V8 4 speed Super


Club member Cyril Croker also stirs up the dust in competitive events in his buggy and not in his immaculate P76.

Hi Everyone, Some interesting information you might INTEREST YOU.

The RON (research Octane Number) quoted on fuel's is the fuel's ability to withstand compression without self ignition. The higher the RON the more compression required to self ignite. Diesel for example has a low RON because it needs to ignite without the assistance of an ignition system. Lower Octane rated fuels can cause run on and/or engine knock (pinging) in higher compression engine failure. The side effects of higher octane fuel's in lower compression engines is increased combustion temperatures, not very acceptable for air cooled motors.

Hope this is helpful to you.





