Notes from the Hunter Valley

General notes:

Known to most motor racing fans would be Formula one driver, Mark Webber. Mark's family purchased Bridge Motors in the main St of Queanbeyan in 1955 that became a Leyland Dealership.

Looking into the history of Hyundai Cars was a surprise as the first Hyundai cars were built by engineers from Ford Australia in 1967. They were on loan to the Hyundai Motor Company. Their mission was to help the Koreans to get their licence built version of the Ford Cortina into production.

A project that I have been involved in for many years was the building of a car Museum in Oberon near the Historic Rail Museum. Our Skoda – Tatra Museum opened to the public last month. One interesting car on display is a Tatra 603 with an air cooled rear engine V8.

Turning the clock back to 1997 and to the NBN Channel 3 Telethon which involved our P76 Car Club. 
