

Grenfell Lights Family Poker Run on Friday 20th September 2024 presented by the Grow Grenfell Group Inc (GGG) in association with the Grenfell Car Club Inc and the Veteran, Vintage, Classic Vehicles Club of Grenfell Inc to especially celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Targa Florio as the “featured car” of the event.

Grenfell Grow Group are pleased to offer the P76 owners a limited number of complimentary home-stays as guests of our GGG/Grenfell Car Clubs member base. For many of the home-stays this offer also comes with the bonus of under-cover garaging for your cars during your stay in our township.

The **Grenfell Lights Family Poker Run** will have the following features:

- Friday 20 September**—park-up of cars in the lower-end of Main Street from 5.30pm followed at 6.15pm with a visit to the Grenfell Silos Lightshow by participants with their motor vehicle and then a short drive to the Grenfell Golf Club for drinks/dinner and a friendly Car Quiz with some great prizes.
- Saturday 21 September**—Our Family Poker Run will start at the Grenfell Bowling Club at 9.30am (1st poker card) and the proposed route will take cars from Grenfell to Harden (85 klms and 2nd poker card). On to Boorowa for lunch (a further 39 klms and the 3rd poker card) and then on to Koorawatha (61 klms and the 4th poker card) and then back to Main Street Grenfell (41 klms and the 5th and final poker card).
Our Poker Run is all on bitumen roads with a number of the sections of the route on quiet country back-roads with the added bonus of stunning bright yellow spring-time canola and lush green wheat crops as a visual backdrop for the drive.
Entrants will complete their journey and collect their 5th and final poker card at Farm & Fable in the lower-end of the main street of Grenfell by mid afternoon and “Park-Up” their cars. We are making arrangements for a number of gift shops and other retail outlets along our main street to be open on the Saturday afternoon of our event.
Cars will leave the main street at 5.45pm for cocktails and dinner at the Grenfell Bowling Club from 6pm on the Saturday night with winners announced and prizes awarded for those that have great and not-so-great poker hands collected from their travels during the day.
- Sunday 22 September**—there will no doubt be some form of breakfast gathering arranged for entrants and our club members.

In Summary:

The **Grenfell Lights Family Poker Run** will become the major fund-raising event for our Grow Grenfell Group which is in the early stages of establishing the **Grenfell Lights** as a tourism drawcard for our historic town.

We have completed our light-up of the *Grenfell Silos Lightshow* in December last year as Stage 1 of our **Grenfell Lights** initiative. It is a world-class lighting installation at the Grenfell Silos and now operational every night of the year from sunset to 9.45pm. It features state-of-the-art coloured and computerised lights that create a moving canvas upon Melbourne artist Heesco’s stunning large-scale mural which he created on the silos back in 2018.

Grenfell is commencing work on lighting-up the main street with permanent coloured and programmable lights being installed on the facades of our historic buildings (in the style of Sydney’s Vivid Festival) and there will be a number of installations completed and lit-up every night from sunset by 21 September.

We are currently waiting on a confirmation of landed cost and an estimated arrival date.


The company we have placed our order with is also investigating a modified off the shelf performance replacement. Once more information becomes available I will share it with everyone.
