The Secretary's P76 Restoration Project (with pictures)

Hello again fellow P-Nuts and Fans! Here is part 7, the next exciting instalment of... "The Secretary's P76 Restoration Project" (with pictures).

Continuing on from last month:

Everything looked great, so I set off to drive home. About half way home... my *Horn Rubber and Pad* fell off into my Lap!!! As *Rove used to say* "WHAT THE!!!"... I panicked thinking the Steering Wheel was next to fall off, so quickly pulled the car over.

I had a quick look at the Horn Pad and noticed they had *ripped it off* tearing all 3 Horn Rubbers in half. I was horrified!

I also noticed the Indicator Wand was all loose, and no longer cancelling after cornering. I decided to get the car home as soon as possible and have a closer look at the damage.

They must have tried to straighten the alignment of my steering wheel and obviously were *not* familiar with this type of beastie. The lugs were all broken off the Cowling that houses the indicator mechanism and the retaining screws were stripped!

Fortunately I had just wrecked a *Peel me a Grape* Super V8, (but that's another story) and had the foresight to keep all the steering column bits and pieces. So I got a *reconditioning!*



As above, I painted the new plastic Cowling pieces and threw out all the old broken parts. I decided to replace the column Bush and Bearing whilst I was there, why not? I screwed the indicator mechanism back into place and re-assembled the column. I also had a good set of 2nd hand Horn Rubbers from the *Peeled Grape*, so I put the steering wheel back together.

I must have done a good job, because everything was working great out on the test drive.

I later complained to Pedders about the dodgy work done on my car. The Manager apologised and I got my next car job done for free. *Better luck next time!*

The old Leyland was starting to look very good indeed. Here is a nice photo of her under my carport, just outside my house.




Need friendly advice about Australia's own car - the Leyland P76?
