There is currently a Targa Florio on e-bay listed for \$25,000.




### Loretta's report:

Such a beautiful variety of cars from 1978 and earlier, the day was filled with checking out everyone elses cars and listening to stories of other people who's parents, grandparents or their own Leyland ownership. The towns of Wallaroo, Kadina and Moonta were where copper mines operated from 1859 until 1923 and added to Kapunda and Burra saved S.A. from bankruptcy. They are situated on the York Peninsular of S.A. approx. 150 kms. Nth of Adelaide.

Every two years the "Copper Triangle" as it is called, host the "Kerneweck Lowender" festival (Celtic Festival) that runs for a week culminating with the cavalcade of vintage, veteran & classic cars trucks & motor bikes on the Sunday.

What excitement we felt heading off from Kapunda (the first copper mine in S.A.(1842) in the mid north of S.A.) at 5.30 am on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> may to participate in the cavalcade of cars on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> may (the weather was warm and sunny).

This was a nostalgic trip for Peter as he grew up in Kadina. We arrived at the north shore caravan park Wallaroo at 8.30 am, set up camp and re-detailed the cars and two boot trailer of road grime and locust's blood and guts. Our Leylands sure created interest !!!! ( while Peter conversed with enthusiastic people)

At the Caravan Park we saw a black Statesman Caprice, two Morris Minors, a mustang and Sunbeam Alpine (that blew an oil line and couldn't participate in the cavalcade). Our Leyland's purred like contented cats all the way. How proud we are at all the interest our Leyland's and the two boot B.B.Q. created.

Anyway, time to tour!! Peter showed me where their home used to be (now has four houses on the block) and Mrs. Harris ( who could talk under concrete) lived ( neighbor) then the Kadina high school onto the Guide Hall where a gem and mineral show was held ( yes we bought stuff), then onto the Farm Shed Museum where we saw heaps of gear our parents and grandparents used, and the first sleeper cab semi trailer built by a family friend ( Wilf Harris)

This Museum is on the must tour list!!! One needs all day to get through it. (Ed. Note. Also a gofher). We then had a ride on the little trains (big boys toys). Also on the premises is Matta Matta house (mine managers residence) which is a home we could sure live in, fire places in all rooms, the boys room out back next to the kitchen complete with wood stove and hip bath.

After a visit with another family friend ( whom Peter had not seen for 50 years) we enjoyed a gourmet vegetarian pizza at a new shop in Kadina. We then checked out where the dinner dance was to be held that night and back to Wallaroo to prepare for the dinner dance which was sponsored by Rosewarnes of Kadina R.A.A. and Holden dealers ( run by the 5<sup>th</sup> generation of Rosewarnes. A very enjoyable night!!! Food yummy, band good and company enjoyable.

We met people from various parts of Victoria, N.S.W., the west coast S.A., Mt. Gambia and other towns in S.A. (an incentive to others!!! These people journey to this function every 2 yrs.

We left the dinner dance early as we had to be up with the birds to pack up and get to the marshalling area so that we would be close to the front of the cavalcade. Gates opened at 7.00am start of run at 10.00am

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup>, cold start to the day, we were 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> in linefor the cavalcade of 473 veteran, vintage and classic cars. We breakfasted on egg and bacon burgers with people owning Mini's, Holden's, Jaguar's, Fire truck's, volkswagen's, Morris's, Austin's, Zepher's, Ford's of all description, vintage truck's and many other makes and models (some people were in period costumes). The best in my opinion (apart from our Leylands of course) was the hippie comby van with passengers in period gear (NO free love or drugs)

We began our cavalcade with motor bikes. It was a heart warming experience for us as people showed much joy at seeing our Leylands. ( map of route attached)!
