





GULLIVARS (FILMERS) TRAVELS AUG 28 2011

We left Alice Springs and headed eventually to Mt. Isa and did the touristy thing there, including an underground mine tour at a purpose built mine. From there we went to the old Mary Kathline uranium mine and township. The open cut mine was quite impressive but the town which housed over 1000 people only has sealed streets and cement building slabs left. I had previously been into Rum Jungle near Darwin so have now seen the two uranium mines which were in operation and so learnt about at school. It was here that I broke the spring U bolts on one side of the van so had a quick trip ack to M Isa Supercheap for a couple more.

Today I am sitting in a camping area a few k's out of Barcaldine (you will need a ueenslander to pronounce it correctly) alongside a river weir, it has plenty of water in it although only 50m wide. There are supposed to be fish in it but I have not tried my luck yet. Might over the next couple of days.

My official retirement date is today, so I am no longer on holidays but a man of leisure I am sure I was meant to be. Tust all is going well

SEPT. 22ND 2011

We are now half-way through our holiday period and still enjoying the experience of camping and exploring new areas. We have "wised up" though ,in that we try to stay in one spot for at least 2 nights now. For a start we were expecting to move on daily but found the packing and moving and then unpacking the van a bit onerous,

Weare now camped on Theresa creek (to Sth. Ausies it is a river) and have been here nearly a week! This is the longesr in any one place, and we find that a river or large waterhle is a great attraction for a lengthy stay. Wayne has tried to fish but now he avows that there are no barramundi or yellow belly here despite what others say.

The nearest town is Clemont which is 21k's away. We are travelling to the town tomorrow for a mine tour, some shopping, a little more tourism of local interests and to complete our correspondence in the library which has good internet coverage.

Briefly; to get to this spot from Alice Springs, we travelled the Plenty Highway, which then changed name to Donohue Highway(misnomer to my way of thinking) once we got to the Queensland border. The road was sometimes little more than a trackband all of it unsealed.

Then to Mt.Isa as I needed to get Nepal Christmas presents bought and posted. The parcel could take 3 months to get to its destination, if it makes it at all!! Then south again to friends at rubyvale where they mine for Sapphires. This is a hobby for them and they spend 6 months at the mine, as most other miners do, and 6 months at theirbase, which is in the case of our friends is Victor Harbor.

First instalment of Michael's P76 STORY

Stage 1

FIRST THERE WAS A BEGINNING WITHOUT A P76.

In the early 90's I stated rallying driving a Peugeot 404, purchased from Chris Jones – a student with no resources except enthusiasm who I met on a control point when he was in the top 10 in a state rally.

I had gone to watch Barry Lowe, who haviing won numerous state and national championships in a 4WD Subaru's, had built a FDird Falcon GT phase 2 rally car to slide like you are meant too.

Barry was killing it- beating 4WD turbo's, bt there was this battered 1964 404 in the top ten being pushed into control. Fencing wire held up the exhaust through screwdriver holes punched in the floor, but the roll cage looked strong. \$2,000 bought a rslly car capable of daily driving, and scaring rally drivers who spent lots more on weekends. Idrove the car to work, rollcage, full harness and all, and rallied when I could. I was hooked.

In Port Lincoln I had ridden endure's, and after accidents and pain took up dirt circuit racing, with a free acces multi cornered circuit only 5 minutes from home with no CAMS involvement. A purpose built 351 Ford open wheeler wiyh wing held the local record for 7 years, but rallies were the ultimate challenge, and by now living in Adelaide with no local dirt circuit club, a \$2,000 fully equipped rally car, road registered, was definitely the answer.

Chris Jones became my mechanic, navigator and extremely good friend. We rallied that 404 and then a series of Renault 12's to death courtesy of "Parts of distinction" with Jason Adams now operating Mainstyle Motoes in the city.

In 1995 there was an Around Australia event. 20,000kms in 20 days, with over 1/3 competitive special timed stages. A true marathon rally, with a year of sprint rally kms. In only a couple of days. With 160km and longer competitive stages.

Ihad 2 kids at school, a mortgage that I could hardly afford, was buying out parteners, and notwithstanding huge efforts could not find a dollar of sponsorship help for my desired 504 Peugeot campaign.

It was clearly a \$30,000 effort (service crew, two vehicles, a \$7,500 entry fee & 40,000 k's travel/accommodation) and without sponsorship it WAS IMPOSSIBLE.


